
4 SIDES

Objective:

Using everyone's input to reach a joint solution.

Work method

- Step 1: Each group of four students is given a sheet of paper. They draw a rectangle in the middle. This is the common base. Students then draw lines from the corners of the rectangle to the corners of the sheet of paper. These four squares belong to each student individually.
- Step2:Givestudentsanassignment/question/exercise.Everyonewritestheiranswerindividually in a corner of the sheet.
- Step 3: Then the group members try to come to a common answer. They argue their answers and listen to the others.
- Step 4: Students write their common answer in the rectangle in the middle



Examples:

You can use this for questions or problems for which multiple solutions are possible. Define a strategy together

Write down a question or problem to be solved. How will you do it? Everyone writes down. Then they compare and choose. This common option is written in the middle.
