

# TEAM FIGHT: WHO PICKS FIRST

## Target

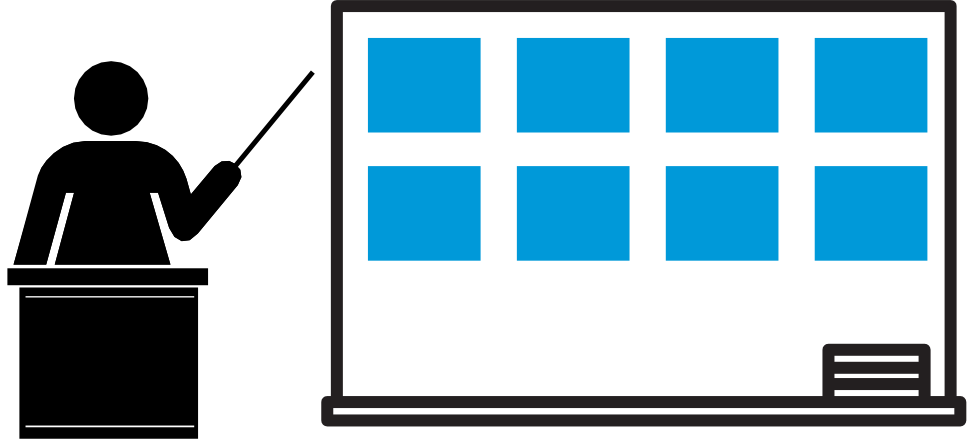
Practising or testing the material

## Preparation

About 20 A sheets with answers (not too long, concepts or years for example), tape.

## Work method

Stick on the board in front of the class a large number of A-sheets with answers to a given topic. Each paper contains only one answer.



Divide the class into two teams.

Each team has a representative for the class.

Teams take turns asking a question to which an A-sheet on the board should form the answer.

When team A asks a question, both students must try to give the answer as quickly as possible by tapping their hand on the correct A page. The one who does this fastest stays on the board. The other is replaced by the next student in his group.

A student notes which team answered the most questions correctly. And that team is, of course, the winner!

## Variation

*Give students a list of questions to ask.*

*Before the match, let the teams think about the questions they can ask (the representatives may not be present, of course).*
