## Target

Students learn to exchange information and knowledge efficiently.
Students learn to evaluate and tolerate another person's opinion.
Students become more linguistically

Work method
Step 1: The teacher divides the class into groups of three or four, and gives each group an assignment: problem, exercise, ...

Step 2: Everyone first thinks about the solution to their group's problem and writes it down concisely


Step 3: One group member remains seated, one moves up one place, one moves up two places up (one goes up three places).

Step 4: In the new groups, participants explain their problem and solution to each other; listeners again take notes and ask clarification questions.

Step 5: Everyone returns to the original groups and passes on the knowledge gained.
