Target

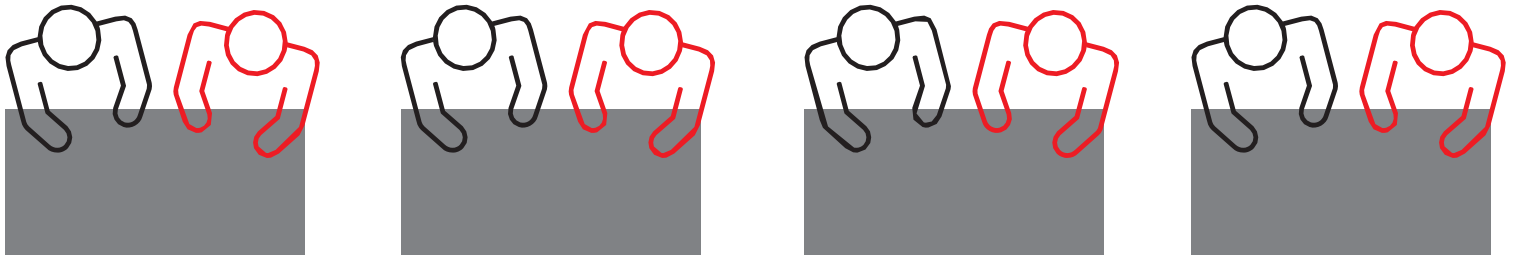
Students learn from each other
Students point out mistakes to
each other

Working method

Groups of 2 students

Students in a group take turns doing a task or exercise.

The pupil whose turn it is is the "mentee". The other mentee(s) ("mentor(s)") are given the task of observing the mentee and giving the mentee advice on how to perform or practise the task better.



Example

A pupil tries to solve or prepare an issue or scientific evidence from A to Z. The mentor observes and gives feedback where necessary. The mentor observes, gives feedback and explains where necessary. When the difficult work comes, the mentor takes over while the mentee watches. This gives the mentee an idea of what he will learn later (=motivate).
