## Target

Practice or repeat concepts

Preparation: make a quartet game or buy an educational quartet.

## Work method

Make a quartet (minimum 40 cards: 10 quartets) on a topic. Make sure the concepts that make up a quartet belong together.

Groups of pupils, with one referee watching, play the quartet. The one with
the most quartets has won.

## Variation

The cards depict concepts or phenomena
The card can be retrieved by giving a correct description of the concept or phenomenon. More exciting is to have each group first create a quartet, which is then played by another group. By the end of a school year, students have enough information to find a set of four concepts under an umbrella term for their subject, especially if they have the books with them. It is quickest to cut thick paper in playing card format on a cutting machine and write with a pen. If necessary, involve the CKV person in making the cards.
